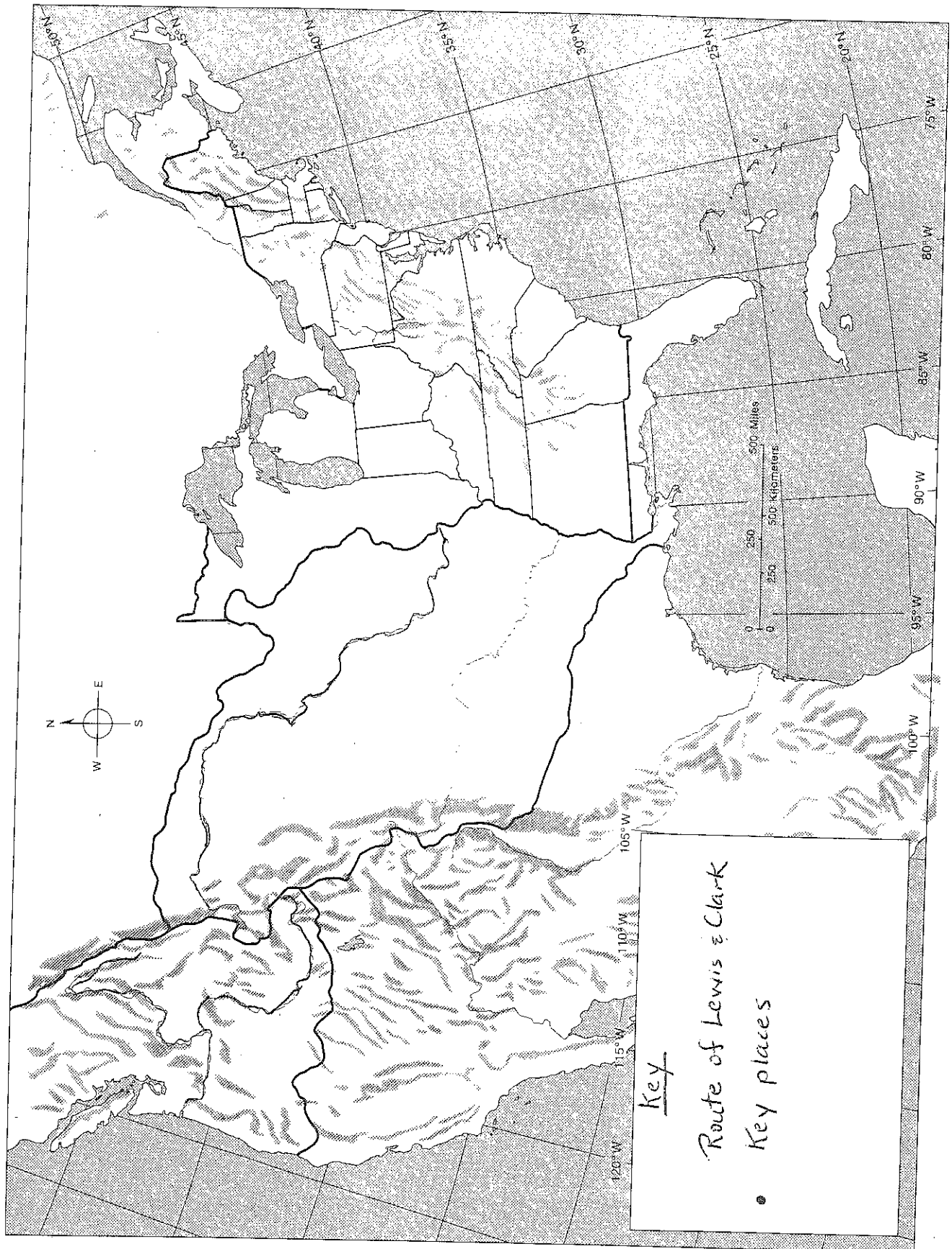

You will follow the directions outlined below, and use the outline map given to you by your teacher. You will be graded on neatness as well as accuracy and completeness.

1. Using the following abbreviations, label the states that existed in 1804 when Lewis and Clark began their expedition. Color this area dark green.
